

Student Attire

The administration and staff believe that the attitude and behaviors of the students are influenced by dress and grooming. With the cooperation of the parents, the school will continue to encourage all students to dress in a fashion that reflects good taste and style appropriate for school. If a style of dress and grooming appears to be disruptive to the educational process or could constitute a threat to the safety or health of students, it will not be permitted in school. The following rules apply to dress:

- Clothing is to be worn as intended.
- Outerwear is not to be worn in school.
- Extremely short or tight shorts/skirts will not be allowed. Shorts and skirts should not be shorter than the fingertips when the arms are hanging at the students' sides with the fingertips extended.
- Clothing exposing mid-bodies, clothing that is "see-through" in nature without appropriate undergarments, or clothing, which is deemed immodest or distracting by the school administration, is not to be worn.
- Shirt straps must be at least 2 fingers wide.
- Head coverings such as hoodies, hats, bandanas, etc. are not to be worn in the building.
- Clothing and/or jewelry with inappropriate and/or offensive materials on them will not be worn.
 - Items, which promote negative religious and/or racial undertones.
 - Items, which promote alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements.
 - Items, which promote obscene, vulgar, or profane words, or pictures.
 - Items, which promote violence or gang activity.
