

**MANHATTAN SCHOOL DISTRICT 114  
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

The Board of Education of Manhattan School District 114, in the County of Will and the State of Illinois, met at Wilson Creek Elementary School on March 22, 2018, for a special meeting to consider the tax levy.

**ROLL CALL**

President, Scott Mancke, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Superintendent Ragon reported to the Board that by abating \$1,488,600, the Levy Extension for FY19 will call for a tax rate of 4.0658 in the capped funds and a tax rate of .1973 in Bond & Interest Fund, for a total rate of \$4.2631. It will generate a revenue of \$10,818,525.03 in capped funds and \$525,000 in Bond & Interest for a total levy of \$11,343,525.03. This represents an increase of \$471,589 at a stable tax rate of \$4.26.

**D. DeCaprio made a motion to approved abatement of Bond & Interest Extension for FY19 in the amount of \$1,488,600 with a second by T. Doyle. All voted Aye. Motion Carried.**

**T. Doyle made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:34 p.m. with a second by D. Murphy. All voted Aye. Motion Carried.**
