Create a color wheel and know the terms "primary colors", "secondary colors", and "complementary colors".

Create an abstract landscape.

Create an Op Art geometric color pattern.

Recognize works of Vincent Van Gogh and Ted Harrison as well as Abstract, Impressionist, Aboriginal, Native American, and Gyo-taku Art.

Create Drawings based on a theme.

Create a clay pinch pot, score and slip additional pieces, and know the terms "kiln" and "firing process".

Create a self-portrait.

Know and draw the standard proportions of the human body.

ART – 4th grade

Create drawings based on a theme.

Create origami pieces.

Demonstrate the use and care of drawing and painting materials.

Create and understand tessellations

Create a scratchboard, show knowledge of linear texture and value contrast

Show knowledge of color pattern.

Create Drawings and paintings of the styles of Realism, Impressionism, and Cubism. Recognize work of MC Escher

Create a pinch pot using clay, add a coil for decoration by scoring and slipping.

Know how to wedge.

Know the terms Fire and Kiln.

ART – 5th grade

Demonstrate the use and care of drawing and painting materials.

Create a portrait in the style of Picasso.

Create one and two point perspective drawings of solid geometric forms

Create a cake using geometric shapes and overlapping skills

Demonstrate knowledge of color blending of tints and shades

Create a landscape demonstrating foreground, middle-ground and background.

Create a figure using correct proportions.

Create a mosaic in the style of Byzantine Art.

Know how to mix all colors on the color wheel.

Create works in the style of Realism Impressionism, Abstract, Op Art, and 20th Century Art. Recognize works by Wayne Thiebaud and Pablo Picasso

Create drawings based on a theme.

Create a pinch and/or a coil pot.
